June 30th, 2k11...YMCA na'ōpio came out to Kūkaniloko to learn of traditional cultural practices here in Lihue at the piko...Wahiawā, Waialua, and Kalihi, were represented...

Waianae YMCA had planned to come but could not attend ...we sat in the shade to talk story with *nalala'ōiwi* Uncle Pila Short and Vicki Pakele...more than 950 years have passed since the birth of Kapawa, the first ruling kapu chief to be born at Kūkaniloko; *liloe kapu* continued for nearly 20 generations until the birth of *Kakuhihewa*, the last ruling kapu chief to be born at Kūkaniloko...we are here today, 38 generations later, remembering through our oral traditions, *oli*, *hula* and *mo'olelo* of our ancestors...na'ōpio left knowing that they are the future of our Nation...one in spirit, one in aloha, the greatest truth of all...mahalo iā keiki o ka 'āina...
