E ho'omaha 'oe me ke aloha-Rest in Love. Robert "Bob" Albin passed away, May 6, 2014, at the age of 86. His wife, Martha, is $l\bar{a}l\bar{a}$ ho'okama Hawaiian Civic Club of Wahiawā. Bob was known for his beautiful woodwork. He was a volunteer on the Battleship Missouri for 14 years up until December 2013 when he became ill. His work there included making the wood ladders, frames for the plaques and displays like the finishing touches on the wooden kiosk for the brochures at the entrance of the Battleship. The teak shop has been named "The Bob Albin Teak Shop" in his honor. Bob was active at Kawaiaha'o and served as a greeter, member of the Handbell Choir, and on the Board of Trustees. When Bob and Martha married in 1999 and moved to their home in Wahiawā Heights, Bob built his own workshop, added a bathroom and a den to his home. Bob "turned bowls", made picture frames and plaques in his leisure time. Bob is survived by his wife, Martha, three stepchildren, six mo'opuna, a sister, and five nieces and nephews. 

Keli'i is a practitioner of *lomilomi, lua*, weapon making and wood carving – photographed here at Pu'ukoholā with his newly crafted *pahu* drum. He and *nālālā ho'okama* Laurel Seeti Douglass and Guy Gaumont of Keokea are our HCCW Maui members. Seeti, a seeker of truth, is a researcher. She diligently examines and questions recorded history of our Nation, ko Hawai'i paeaina. Her investigations began with circumstances in the deaths of Royal Secretary Timoteo Ha'alilio-1844 and Prince Moses Kekuaiwa-1848. Guy is a videographer, producer and editor for their company Maui Film Works, Inc. He has created numerous preservation projects in DVD with Maui *kupuna* and *kanaka mauli* featuring 'ohana, mele, mo'olelo, kalo and much more. He recently produced the audio book "Under Maui Skies" with author Wayne Moniz. Seeti & Guy seek non-profit status for Maui Film & Research to reach the multitudes.
