5. LO-The chiefs of Lihue, Wahiawa, and Halemano on Oahu were called Lo chiefs. Po'e Lo Ali'i ["People from whom to obtain a chief"], because they preserved their chiefly kapus. The men had kapus, the women had kapus and when they joined their kapus and children were born, the children preserved their kapus...Kauakahi'ailani, Ma'ilikukahi, Kalona, Piliwale, Kukaniloko, Pa'akakanilea, [Pa'akanilea], Ka'akauualani, Ka'au, Lale, Paoakalani, Pakapakakuaua, Nononui, Kokoloea and a great many others were Lo chiefs.
