2.16.2k16...Mary Talon, President of The Wahiawa Center for Community Health (WCCH) Board of Directors, invited fellow Hawaiian Civic Club of Wahiawa (HCCW) members to attend a press conference in the courtyard of the Wahiawa Medical Building. On Tuesday, February 16, 2016 at noon, WCCH accepted \$40,000 from Hawai'i Pacific Health. Mary Talon received a check for \$20,000 from Pali Momi Medical Center and a check for \$20,000 from Straub Clinic & Hospital. These funds will assist in efforts to provide affordable, quality and accessible health care for Wahiawa and the surrounding rural communities. HCCW members in attendance in addition to Mary Talon were Kupuna Velma Aloha Kekipi, Hildegard Uilani Akee and Jonette Buza. This was the first major public announcement of the plans for WCCH and it was filmed by a crew from the Wahiawa 'Ōlelo Community Media Center located at the Leilehua High School campus. Facilities are expected to be up and running by summer 2016. Services will include comprehensive primary care and preventative care for Wahiawa residents and surrounding rural communities - to include clinical, dental and behavioral health services. Future programs to include the medical *haumana* of JABSCOM and the pre-nursing *haumana* of UHWO are also in the planning stages. Again, *Ho'omaika'i* to everyone involved...eō
