





'Ōlelo No'eau... Hawaiian proverb #2059 MARY KAWENA PUKUI ... *Mai ka ho'oku'i a ka hālāwai.* From zenith to horizon. An expression much used in prayers. In calling upon the gods in prayers, one mentions those from the east, west, north and south, and those from the zenith to the horizon.

'Ōlelo No'eau... Hawaiian proverb #2066 MARY KAWENA PUKUI ... Mai ka piko o ke po'o a ka poli o ka wāwae, a la'a ma na kihi 'ehā o ke kino. From the crown of the head to the soles of the feet, and four corners of the body. Expression used in prayers of healing. The four corners: the shoulders and hips; between them, the vital organs of the body.
