08.07.2020 ... Kahuiaio Site #3716 visit at Kuaokala Ridge to survey this area overlooking Kaena Point. In December 2019, the first group of practitioners were taken to *Mokaena Heiau* to present *ho'okupu*. It has been very quiet since then. The Department of Defense, DOD, directed postponement of the proposed Homeland Defense Radar indefinitely. Alternative sites are being investigated. There's a possibility that funds will once again be allotted to this project by the Senate and House Armed Services Committees. We are especially interested in the Environmental Impact Statement, EIS. The Office of Hawaiian Affairs, OHA, contacted *Pelekikena* Noelani De Vincent and *Ka Ho'opa'a Mo'olelo a me Pu'ukū* Kalimapau to participate as members of this Hui. The Kūkaniloko Master Plan Working Group, KMPWG, members met monthly from 2016-2018 to lay the foundations for development of the 511 acres of land surrounding State Monument Kukaniloko Birthstones. KMPWG included HCCW members: *Mea Pule La'akapu* Lenchanko, *kūka'awe* Tom Lenchanko, Ku'uipo Laumatia and Kalimapau. Work continues into the next phase of the Kūkaniloko Master Plan. The first formal KAH virtual meeting was held today at 5 pm. *Eō*
