01.27.2k21 ... 'Āina Kūkākūkā ... Today, six HCCW nā lālā 'ōiwi met for brunch as opportunity arose to learn about the care provided for other sacred pōhaku of our temple, O'ahu. Nā Pōhaku Ola Kapaemahu A Kapuni - The Healing

(Wizard) Stones of Kapaemahu... Kane: Kapaemahu a me Kinohi. Nā Wahine: Kapuni a me Kahaloa are located in Waikiki at Kūhiō Beach. These special *pōhaku* have a very deep history dating back to a time long before the reign of Kakuhihewa, last Ali'i to be born at Kūkaniloko in the 16th century. These *pōhaku* were placed at their location in Waikiki in tribute to four healers who came from Tahiti centuries ago. Their powerful mana and use of la'au lapa'au plants and animals from the land and seas focused their healing practices. These Nā Pōhaku Ola were rediscovered in the early 1900's and in 1997, nearly 100 years later, renowned la'au lapa'au Papa Henry Auwae and the Queen Emma Foundation established their current permanent care and location. During this restoration, a delegation from Tahiti was present for ceremony. They placed the 5th and final pohaku from Tahiti named Ta'ahu as their *ho'okupu* to join the others. Papa Henry Auwae added four medicinal plants to this tribute: Ma'o - Hawaiian cotton; 'Ohe -Hawaiian bamboo; *Makahala* – Wild Tobacco; and *Naupaka kahakai* – 5

spindled beach Naupaka. Perpetual care by Na Haumana La'au Lapa'au O Papa Auwae continues this day. Mahalo nūnui to Kūka'awe Kawailani Soma, for sharing your mo'olelo. As haumana of Papa Auwae, she has been significant in caring for these *pōhaku* for the past 24 years. *Nā Pōhaku Ola Kapaemahu A Kapuni* ...the past is always present.
