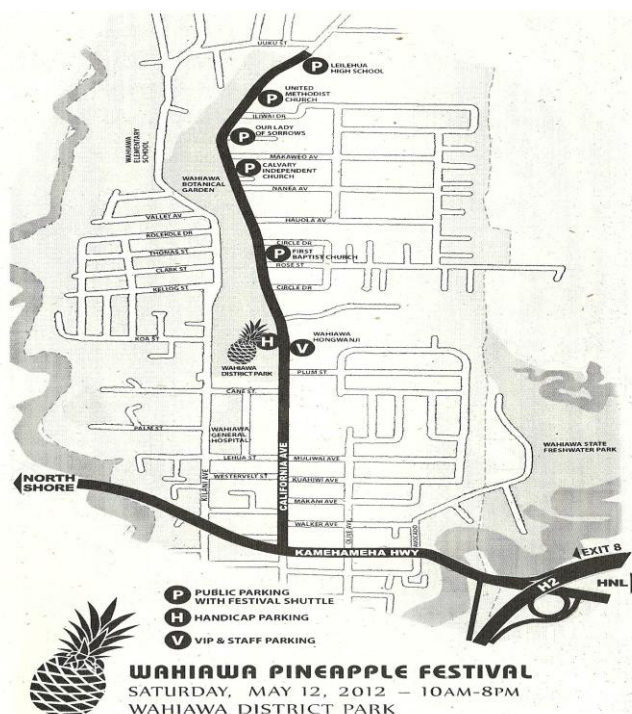

June 13th, Wednesday...HCCW monthly meeting...Wahiawā Police Station Conference Room...7pm...Please join us for this very important meeting. HCCW has been awarded the *Ho'olako Nā Kiwila Grant* of \$1500 through *Hawai'i Maoli*. Our grant, The Hawaiian Civic Club of Wahiawā 2012 Visitor Survey Data Compilation for kapa ahu awa kūkaniloko a.k.a. Kūkaniloko Birthstones State Monument is the first step in the direction of re-establishing *Nā Hale A'o Aha Kūkaniloko Learning Center*. A part of the Learning Center will address the visitor so demographics and statistics are vital. This will be an on-site, person to person survey. The grant provides a means to acquire the equipment and supplies needed to obtain and process the information. We will need to cover 138 hours in the 30 day survey period from *June 15th - Iulai 16th*. There will be a minimum requirement of two general members, or associate members or your respective 'āina (family) to cover each hour. However, any number of people can sign up for the same period of time, especially for weekends when there are many, many visitors simultaneously.

I have attached a copy of the actual survey form for your review. Forms will be onsite each day for your use. Your signature will be required upon completion of each survey. Please take a look at the hours that we need to cover. The grant will only finance the cost of equipment and supplies. *Nā mea ana 'āina*, surveyors, will be on a voluntary basis. It will take a few weeks to arrange and co-ordinate the schedule. The sooner we start the better. Mahalo to lālā 'ōiwi, Ryn Lenchanko-Rodrigues, who has volunteered to be the Assistant Project Manager. We hope to build a foundation with the material gathered and to create a website for Kūkaniloko, managed solely by the Hawaiian Civic Club of Wahiawā. *Mahalo piha* for your co-operation and Aloha!
