HCCW has been awarded the *Hoʻolako Nā Kiwila Grant* of \$1500 through *Hawaiʻi Maoli*. Our grant, The Hawaiian Civic Club of Wahiawā 2012 Visitor Survey Data Compilation for kapa ahu awa kūkaniloko a.k.a. Kūkaniloko Birthstones State Monument is the first step in the direction of re-establishing *Nā Hale Aʻo Aha Kūkaniloko Learning Center*. A part of the Learning Center will address the visitor so demographics and statistics are vital. This will be an on-site, person to person survey.
