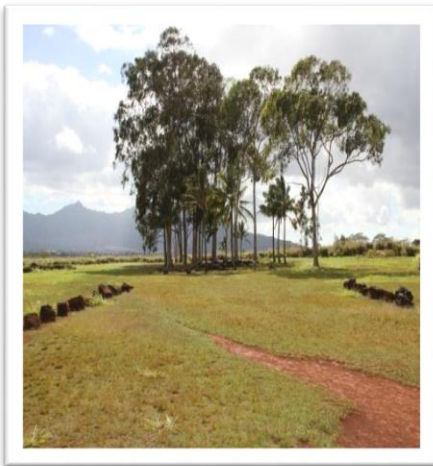

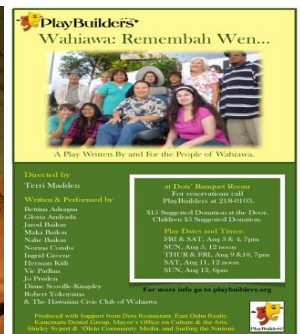

We, the Hawaiian Civic Club of Wahiawa, far surpassed our expectations for the **2012 Kūkaniloko Birthstones State Monument Visitors Survey**. Individually and collectively, we have attained a broader understanding of the global interest in and influence of Kūkaniloko. The one constant sentiment from each visitor was an "extreme reverence" for our *wahi kapu*. There were visitors from Italy, France, Germany, Spain, Canada, Australia, Korea, China, India and many other countries. The Nation of Japan, however, comprised the greatest number of visitors each day. There were multitudes of zip codes from the Continental United States as well. The most significant, although a small percentage during this short period, were the Hawaiians. *Kanaka maui* came to maintain the grounds by giving water to the established and newly introduced plant life; to offer *oli* and *makana* as they connected to and centered at the *piko*, Kūkaniloko; and to carry on traditions of their *'āina*, *'ohana*, *hālau hula* and *kupunama*. Together we protect, preserve and perpetuate our Nation, *ko Hawai'i paeaina...eō*

July 16th, 2k12, the physical recording of the **2012 Kūkaniloko Birthstones State Monument Visitors Survey** is complete. A total of 350 combined volunteer hours and 100 management hours have been executed. The standard value of these In-Kind services @ \$17.94 per hour totals \$8,073. Many more hours will be dedicated to summarizing questions asked of our visitors. As required by the Final Report due August 15th, 2012 for the Ho'olako Nā Kiwila Grant from Hawai'i Maoli, statistics are tallied as follows: (1) Club member volunteers – 21 (2) non-Club member volunteers – 5 (3) new members – 8 (4) Adult Visitors – 2,650 (5) Keiki Visitors – 442 (6) *Kanaka maui* – 370 (7) Total Visitors for the 34 day period of the Survey – 3,092 people...*auwe!* *Mahalo piha* to all volunteer *Na mea ana 'āina* (surveyors), HCCW members and non-members alike...
