'Ōlelo no'eau...Hawaiian proverb #2066... MARY KAWENA PUKUI ... Mai ka piko o ke po'o a ka poli o ka wāwae, a la'a ma na kihi 'ehā o ke kino. From the crown of the head to the soles of the feet, and four corners of the body. Expression used in prayers of healing. The four corners: the shoulders and hips; between


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#### HCCW Mei - May 2k17
