Nā Pōhaku Hānau o Kūkaniloko Welcoming Ceremony Protocol

na HCCW Kahu Peter Lonoae'a

1. **CONCH SHELL** - blower uses "Lua Protocol" blowing at least 4 times, once in each direction – Ākau, Hema, Hikina, Komohana – recognizing the winds that blow into the Hawai'i archipelago... as the visitors enter from the Hikina (East) entrance and then again at the Hema (South) entrance announcing their arrival.

2. VISITORS: Mele Kāhea – Song/Chant/Spoken words asking permission to enter by group or by individual

- 3. HCCW: Mele Komo Song/ Chant granting permission to enter by a member of HCCW
- 4. VISITORS: Ho'okupu presented at this time if water, only one person. Followed by Mele Mahalo by HCCW
- 3. HCCW: Hoʻokupu "Mai kākou I pū pa´akai" presentation to our visitors
- 5. HCCW: Pikai or Cleansing Ritual by Kahu Lonoae'a using salt water and lau ki or ti leaf done for each individual who wants to this is by choice and not mandatory. Followed by the Honi or traditional greeting ...exchanging "HA" the essence of breath of life.

*Note: for larger groups Kahu will **Pikai Nā Kane** as a group, followed by **Pikai Nā Wahine** as a group.

Cleansing Pule from Lua Protocols:

Mai ka piko o ke po'o	May this Pikai cleanse you from the top of your head
o ka poli o ka wāwae	to the bottom of your feet,
a la'a ma nā kihi'ehā o ke kino	and the four corners of your body.
Amama ua noa lele wale	The prayers are finished, free from kapu, let them fly

8. HCCW: Mele Aloha – Song/ Chant of Welcome to all, both the seen and unseen. Tag with a:
Mele Pale – Song/ Chant asking Peaceful Beings in the heavens to clear a path from any negative or unwelcomed presence. (HCCW)

9. HCCW: On-site presentation of **Ke Ao 'O Kūkaniloko** (Enlightenment of Kūkaniloko) with Tom Lenchanko or with Kumu Kahuiao - Kumu Noelani, Kumu Peter, Kumu Kalimapau - through our Ka Piko Huaka`i Lohe Ana - Piko Listening Journey.

10. VISITORS: When your visit is complete, Oli Mahalo by visiting group or an individual

11. HCCW: will respond in kind by an individual or as a group.

12. We are Complete Mahalo!
